



## PUTTING OUR FAITH INTO ACTION



Welcome to the 113th Annual Convention of the Utah State Council of the Knights of Columbus. For 113 years, the Knights in Utah have grown from humble beginnings starting with Council 602 at the Cathedral to currently 37 total councils boasting over 3,000 members. We now cover the state from Logan to St George and from Vernal to Wendover. Our presence is felt in the over 82,000 square miles of this great state.

We are Knights in action. We offer men a place to lead their families and communities in faith and service, and put that “Faith into Action”. Our Knights have involved themselves, their parishes and families and have taken the opportunity to make a meaningful difference through our Faith in Action program; namely Faith, Community, Family, and Life.

So who and how have we helped and assisted this year. **Faith** activities provided support to our priests and seminarians, the Carmelites, conducting Rosaries, and providing aid to people in foreign lands. **Community** efforts supported Coats for Kids, Free Throw Challenge, Helping Hands and Soccer Challenge. **Family** activities reinforced Family of the Month and Year, Food for Families and Keep Christ in Christmas. We also sponsored scholarship programs for our youth.

Our **Life** programs have blossomed with Christian Refugee Relief, March for Life, Mass for Special Needs, Ultrasound and Pregnancy Center Support, the Silver Rose tour, and Special Olympics. Specifically, we have helped abortion-minded women choose life by viewing their unborn children at three pregnancy resources centers around the state through our ultrasound initiative program. We recently purchased and blessed the 4<sup>th</sup> ultrasound machine which replaced the aging unit servicing the Brigham City area. And the list of great accomplishments due to selfless giving of time, resources and talent goes on and on.

Then came March. Between COVID-19 and earthquakes, the world changed. Social distancing, teleworking and stay at home became our daily routine. One of the casualties of the pandemic was the transition to virtual meetings, but we will work together and get through these challenging times. This year’s state convention was dramatically changed to an abbreviated online meeting with none of the social gathering we all look forward to every year. Hopefully, some of the activities and awards skipped can be provided at the Organization Meeting.

Recapping my second year as State Deputy, overall the rewards have outweighed the challenges. Through all the planning, meetings, traveling, exemplifications and visiting new places, I would venture to say we have done a good job of carrying out the Venerable Father Michael McGivney’s vision to help others. As our Supreme Knight Carl Anderson said “Whether at home or abroad, charity is our Order’s first principle and the basis for all we do as brother Knights. It is the tangible way that we live out that spirit of fraternity and ‘missionary discipleship’ to which Pope Francis has called us.”


However, we haven’t done a good job of bring new men into the Order this year, so there’s work to be done. That will be our biggest challenge as we finish this year and move forward into the next.







**The Trappist Monks of Huntsville Utah** supported themselves by farming and beekeeping on the Abbey's 1,840 acres of land. Among other goods, they sold bread, creamed honey, and handmade clocks in the gift shop. In 1972, *Mother, St. Teresa* visited the Huntsville Abbey for a retreat with the monks, at the invitation of Brother Nicholas Prinster, one of the monks who had spent some time with her. Ultimately unable to remain viable after 70 years in the community, the monks celebrated the Abbey's final Mass on Aug. 27, 2017. Shortly thereafter the prominent stained glass window, "Our Lady of Prompt Succor" was donated to Holy Family Catholic Church in South Ogden. The Abbey of the Most Holy Trinity originally acquired the window, which is 9 feet wide by 21 feet tall, in 1960.




