




## **Survey Results - Data**

- How many Knights are in Utah?
  - 2945 Declined ~ 500 in 2 years
- Last year council avg intake 2.5
  - 11 councils didn't recruit 1 new
- State 8-year Averages
  - Intake: 192
  - Suspensions & Withdrawals: 167
  - Deaths: 36

### Support Your Brother Knights

- Assign as many phone tree callers as possible to check on Brother Knights.
- Assign a member to find contacts for local support organizations.
- Start a "Buddy System" Assign willing members as buddies, to make daily contact with "at risk" members and their families.
- Offer to drive to the grocery store or pharmacy to pick up food, medicine, etc.
- Assemble your council contact information.

### **Support Your Parish**

- Council officers should request to speak with their pastor as soon as possible.
- During the conversation, the council should ask about – and be prepared to deliver on – the requests of the pastor and the needs of the parish community, as well as offer creative ideas for support.
- After the call, map out a strategy to deliver on the pastor's requests.


