



Knights of Columbus Utah State Council Silver Rose Program 2021



Worthy District Deputies,

Supreme has issued a tentative Silver Rose Schedule for 2021. The Silver Rose will be in Utah from June 14th – July 5th (22 Days). It will arrive from Wyoming and leave over to Colorado. Utah is on Route 2, the map at www.KofC.org/Rose shows through which other states our particular rose will travel (February 27th to December 12th).

To streamline the Rose's passage through the State, it was determined that Rose should be passed between the Districts starting in District One and exiting Utah through District Five. The District Deputies should coordinate with their Councils to determine the best Silver Rose prayer program for their District. Also, District Deputies need to Coordinate with the District Deputies above and below them to ensure proper movement of the Rose within the State. Passing the Silver Rose in this fashion will allow **ALL** the councils and/or individuals within a specific District to have the opportunity to participate in a Silver Rose prayer service.

The following is only a **tentative schedule** for passing the Silver Rose through the State:

- District Eleven (Jun 20/21), Frank Lesar, DD (SLC, Park City);
- District Nine (Jun 22/23), Brian Duncan, DD (Tooele, Magna, Riverton, Copperton);
- District Six (Jun 24/25), Jerry Angus, DD (Kearns, West Jordan, WVC, Taylorsville);
- District Three (Jun 26/27), Larry Page, DD (Cottonwood Heights, Draper, Riverton);
- District Seven (Jun 28/29), Tim Soran Jr., DD (Sandy, Holliday, Midvale);
- District Four (Jun 30/Jul 1), John Chavez, DD (Provo, American Fork, Payson);
- District Eight (Jul 2/3), Mark Meredith, DD (Saint George, Cedar City);
- District Five (Jul 4/5) Larry Zubel, DD (Helper, Price, Vernal).

As stipulated, this is only a tentative Schedule, if the District Deputies have a better proposal of passing the Silver Rose through the State, please let us know **by April 30th!**

Program Ideas

Looking forward to 2021, you are encouraged to carry out the program – in-person or virtually - as best fits your jurisdiction's circumstances in-light-of any relevant local civil or diocesan restrictions. The most popular variants of the program include

- 1) hosting a parish-based virtual silver rose prayer service -- an example of a virtual silver rose prayer service is available online at <https://youtu.be/FiKTwKw-3Y4>
- 2) hosting a state-wide virtual silver rose prayer service
- 3) allowing individual families or council members to host the rose at their home to pray privately
- 4) allowing individual families to host a virtual council or family prayer night.
- 5) Another way would be for a couple of Districts to work together to host a Silver Rose prayer program (in-person and/or virtual) where all the councils may participate.

Silver Rose Reporting

The State has to submit Utah’s Silver Rose Jurisdiction plan [#10720](#) to Supreme in advance. If the above proposed plan will not work for your councils and district, you have **until April 30th** to recommend ideas and/or schedule/route changes.

When transferring the Silver Rose between Districts, please record your “Distance Traveled to transfer Rose (in miles)”. It’s needed on **Form 10784** and it will assist us in competing the overall program report.

The Silver Rose reporting log has been retired and councils are to report their hours in the Faith in Action “Fraternal Programs Report Form” [#10784](#) on line at <https://www.kofc.org/fiaforms>.
