STATE DEPUTY'S MESSAGE

I call your name

What a great Organizational meeting we had, thank you to everyone who came. I hope it was beneficial. During my opening remarks I talked about this year's theme "I call your name"; as I mentioned this is not a direct quote from the bible but refers to Isaiah 43:1 – I have called you by name: you are mine. If we were able to accomplish so much, just imagine what we can do this year with the restrictions of the pandemic being lifted.

I also wanted to thank all the Past State Deputies that were present at the Organizational meeting and that continue to be involved. I am very excited about the directors and chairs that are returning, and the new team members we have like Bill McCauley as our State Membership Director. We have a couple of new District Deputies with Patrick McDonald in District 8, Gabino Chacon-Escarcega in District 9, and Beau Parent in District 11. Last year we added 8 new District Deputies and combined with this year we have all new DDs, please give them your support as they are here to give you theirs.

God is calling us by name, our church is in need and calling us, and the Knights are calling us. Will you answer and will you answer by your actions? Remember what Bill McCauley said, the difference between try and triumph is umph. Start the year off by completing the COVID Recovery Program, make a plan for the year on how you will grow and improve over last year, and put in the umph to make it happen.

MEMBERSHIP MESSAGE

A new **Fraternal Year** is here and with it are new goals for us to achieve.

July is the month to set your calendar with the programs and events. Church Drives and membership events are ideal ways to re-introduce your Council to the Parish Community. I have posters and pew cards for your use. Just tell me the contact name and reverse prayers for the pew cards and I will send you the format to print.

Our initial incentive for the year runs from July 1 through September 30:

Fast Start – Best performing council by percentage of membership gain (with forms completed) gets a state hosted steak BBQ (approx. \$300). Minimum of 25% membership gain.

The **Shining Armor Award** program is designed for members of your council to engage in and maintain an active level of participation in council programs and activities. To qualify for the Shining Armor Award, during the fraternal year, brother Knights must:

- Work on at least 3 council Faith in Action programs.
- Attend at least 3 council meetings.
- Attend an Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity.
- Meet with your council's insurance representative or attend a fraternal benefits night.
- Sponsor at least one man who becomes a member of the Order.

There are <u>many ways</u> to ask a man to join the Knights:

the council or parish website, Facebook, Twitter, posters and pew cards, parish email, or even in person.

Remember, welcoming new members into your Council is as easy as:

Acceptance by Council vote.

Bring to Ceremonial (Charity, Unity, Fraternity), can be virtual.

Confirm new status with Supreme (Form 100, or Officers Online/Member Management).

Dues need to be paid ...or did he join online? Dues already paid! (Now through December31, 2021, enter Promo Code: **McGivney2020** for 12 months of free membership) <u>www.KofC.org/joinus</u> (He enters your **council number**, and the **proposer's membership number**).

The only difference between try and triumph is a little "umph". Put that umph in your programs and membership. Best of luck in 2021-2022.



CEREMONIALS CORNER

Ceremonials have always been important to membership in the Knights of Columbus. Over the years I've been a Knight, I've witnessed several changes to how they are done and how the message is imparted. The purpose has always been to impart the message (lesson) in a significant and memorable way. Now that we have the combined ceremonial with the Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity and it's public, we still have an obligation to take ceremonial work seriously. Yes, the Supreme Council does host it on-demand online, <u>www.KofC.org/Ceremonials</u>, but it's not "just another 30 minutes of wasted time" that a new member should fit in between episodes while binge-watching something on Netflix. In years gone by, members were reminded of the importance as the degree team wore robes, and delivered the message from memory. These days the robes have been retired, the ceremonial baldrics elevate the presenter's appearance (as seen in the picture below). Since the new ceremonial is public, and it is recommended to conduct it in the church (following a weekend Mass), efforts are needed to keep the dignity and solemnness of the occasion. To quote from one of the presentations at the Organizational Meeting the last weekend in June: **It's not easy, but it's not complicated!** The script is publicly available in English, Spanish and French, so any brother Knight can review it in advance to ensure a smooth delivery. Let's get ceremonials scheduled, conducted and reported on <u>Form 450</u>!

Pictured at right are the ceremonials teams (wearing the <u>ceremonial bal</u><u>drics</u>) with the new members of Council 6010 in Layton. On Tuesday, June 8th, a bilingual exemplification was held in the church, welcoming new members in both English and Spanish. When the council realized they needed additional baldrics so both teams could wear them, the request went out and the State Membership Director (Ryan Graveley) brought one of the two state traveling Ceremonial Kits to the exemplification. As the State Ceremonials Director, I have one and the State Warden (Alex Tarazon) has the other. The have all the supplies needed for the new ceremonial except the council's Constitutional Roll, and new member kits (with the pin & rosary).
