- EXEMPLIFICATIONS ARE OUR GATEWAY TO FOSTER MEN TO BE OUR LEADERS OF TOMORROW.
- EVERY DISTRICT SHOULD HAVE AN EXEMPLIFICATION TEAM.
- Each Council should schedule one live Exemplification every quarter. Live or virtual Exemplifications will be scheduled as necessary.
- Each District Deputy must schedule and conduct an Exemplification at least once per quarter on average in his district.

Give the candidate your member number so you get credit for the recruitment and your council number so the candidate appears in your council's Candidates tab.



On Signup:

- Emails sent by Supreme to GK, FS,
 Membership Director, Online Membership Coordinator (OMC)
- If no council identified, OMC contacts the new Knight to confirm.
- Emails sent to candidate and GK



No-Nos:

- Completing the online application for a member even if they have asked you to do it.
- Collecting information from a man on a form 100/prospect card and using it to sign the member up for online membership.
- Creating an email account for a member so they can complete the online membership process.



Control:

- Council votes on new member
- Candidate takes the exemplification before or after the vote.




After Vote:

Online Membership Best Practices

- Have the online member register with his own device, but you are permitted to have your device available for prospective members to use.
- Avoid any disruption in the process: When you plan a church drive, or have recently had multiple members join from a single device, please notify Supreme before the event (ideally) or soon after the event. This will ensure that Supreme understands the reason for the IP addresses that will (or have) been used for multiple online memberships.

ONLINE EXEMPLIFICATION SCHEDULE & CANDIDATE INVITATIONS

The online Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity is available on-demand and at scheduled dates and times. Invitations are available for download below and the schedule for the month is listed as well. Before inviting a candidate to participate in the ceremony, make sure your council has completed their standard admissions process and has collected the information needed for his form 100. Councils must file a Form 100 for all candidates who complete an online exemplification.

Welcoming Online Members into your council is as easy as

- A. Council votes to accept the member.
 - i. Can be done <u>electronically</u> (virtually), or during the <u>Council Meeting</u>.
- B. Candidate attends the new ceremonial (Charity, Unity, Fraternity).
 - i. Online Exemplification anytime! Send invitation (PDF) from www.KofC.org/ceremonials (candidate enters your council # and selects "Online Member I am joining a council.")
 - ii. Local team can host a live ceremonial, or even a virtual ceremonial.
- C. Financial Secretary "Form 100" Paperwork
 - i. Using the "Prospect Tab" in Officers Online (if he is listed there).
 - ii. Using the "Candidate Tab" in **Officers Online** (a.k.a. the "electronic Form 100"). **Officers Online** is www.kofc.org/oo
 - iii. As a transfer on the paper Form 100 (send PDF to Supreme via email).

Utah Incentives

- July 1 through September 30
- Fast Start Best performing council by percentage of membership gain (with forms completed) gets a state hosted steak BBQ (approx. \$300). Minimum of 25% membership gain.
- Quarterly (Fourth Fraternal Quarter ends June 15, 2022 for this award)
- Top Recruiter per quarter receives \$150 (minimum 3 Recruits)
- If no winner in a Quarter, Award Money is added to next Quarter
- Yearly thru June 15, 2022
- Council with highest net membership gain for the year receives \$500 Per Capita credit
- **Supreme** will also offer incentives (for recruiters, councils, districts)

Shining Armor Award

- The Shining Armor Award program is designed for members of your council to engage in and maintain an active level of participation in council programs and activities.
- To qualify for the Shining Armor Award, during the fraternal year, brother Knights must:
 - Be involved in at least 3 council Faith in Action programs.
 - Attend at least 3 council meetings.
 - Attend an Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity.
 - Meet with your council's insurance representative or attend a fraternal benefits night.
 - Sponsor at least one man who becomes a member of the Order.

Star Award 2021 - 2022 Fraternal Year

- The Star Council Award recognizes outstanding achievement in membership, insurance and programming. <u>KofC.org/star</u>
- In order to achieve the Star Council Award, a council must earn the Father McGivney, Founder's, and Columbian Awards.
- Additionally, the council must submit both the <u>Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity</u> (#1728) and <u>Service Program Personnel Report</u> (#365).
- In the United States and Canada councils must also be fully compliant with applicable safe environment requirements. KofC.org/Safe



COLUMBIAN AWARD

- This award recognizes excellence in your council's programming and charitable outreach.
- To earn this award your council must conduct and report programs in each of the four program categories (Faith, Family, Community, and Life) for a total of 16 program credits, with four in each category.



FATHER MCGIVNEY AWARD

- This award recognizes excellence in your council's membership growth.
- To win this award your council must meet or exceed its yearly membership quota.
