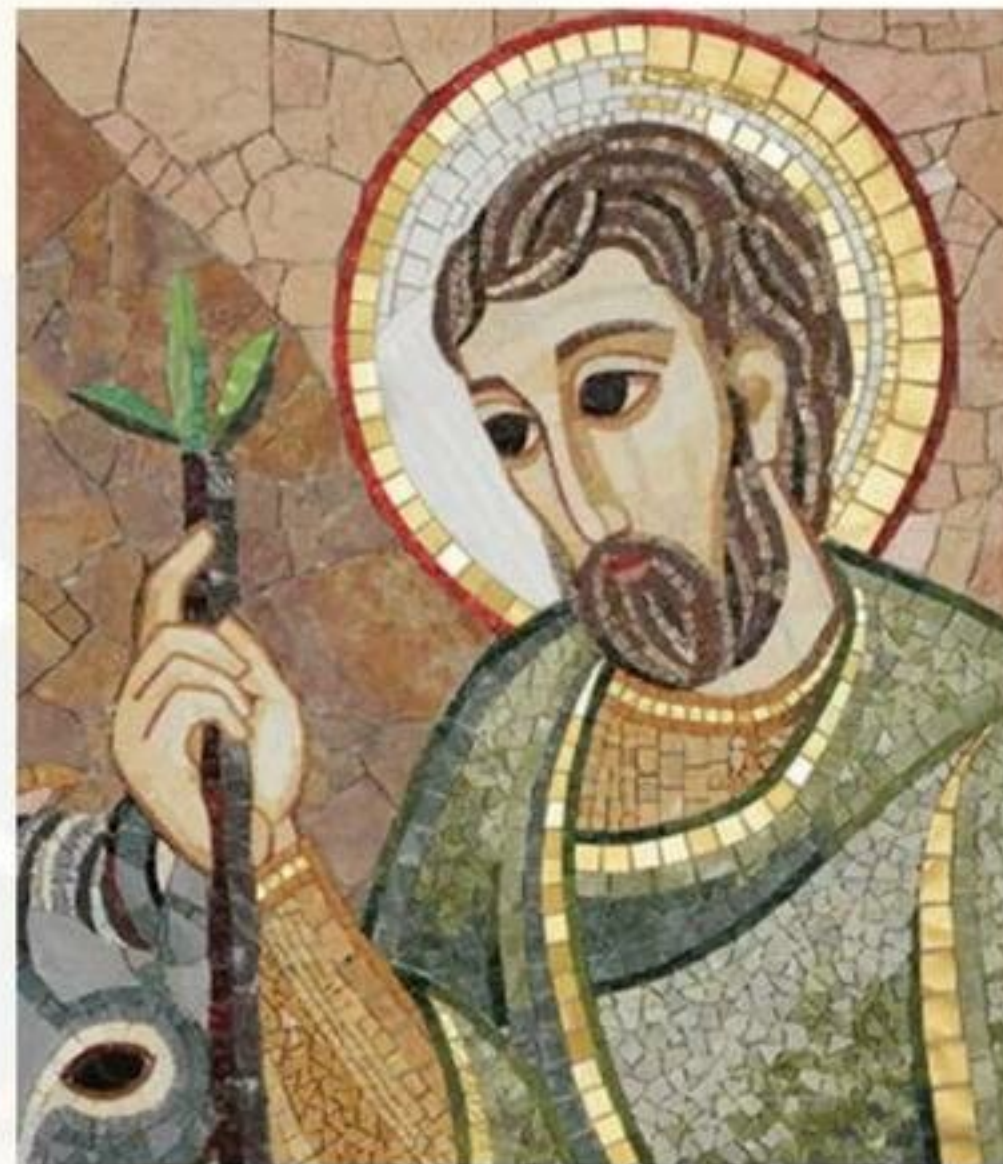

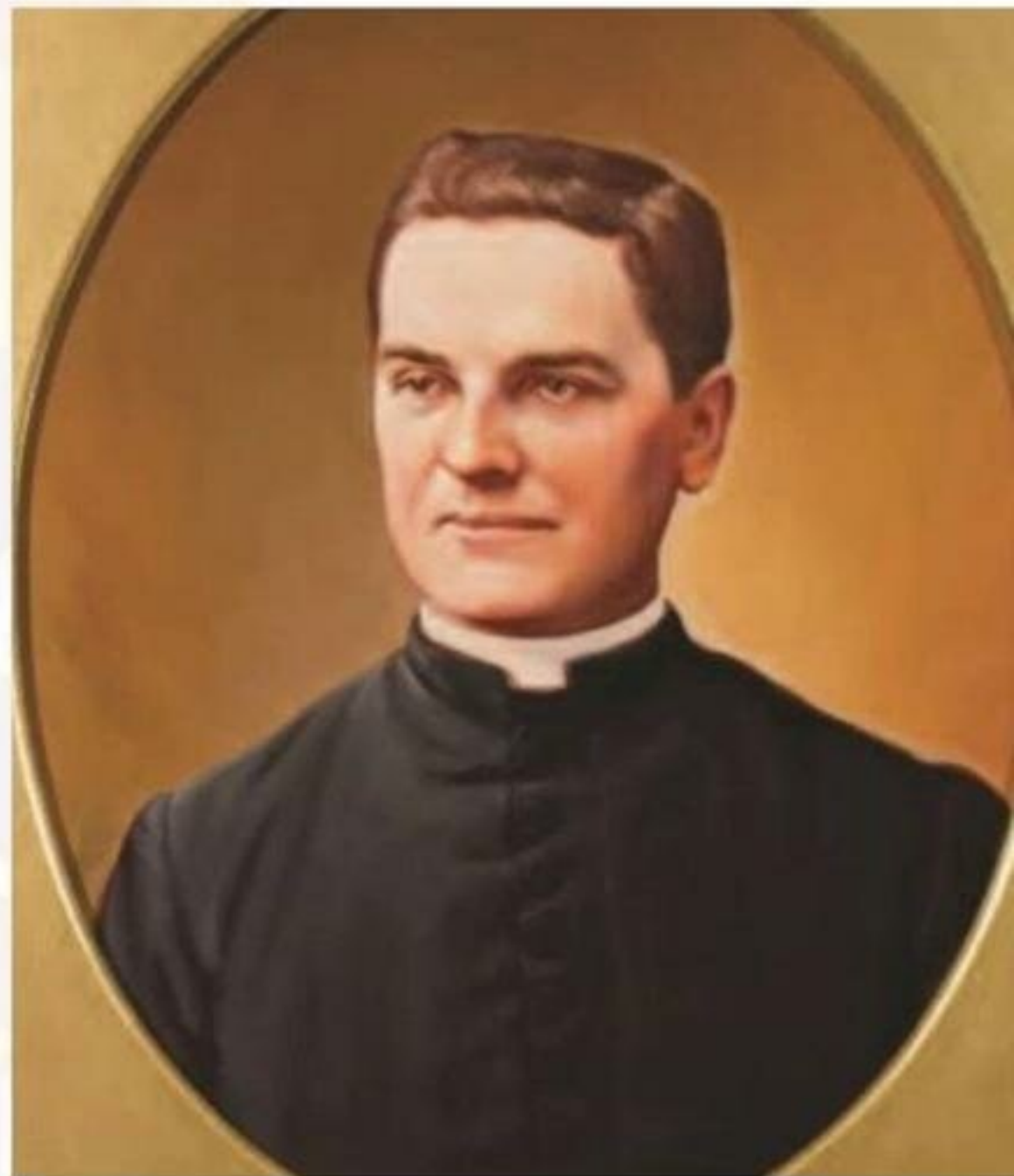

Prayer for the Canonization of Blessed Michael McGivney

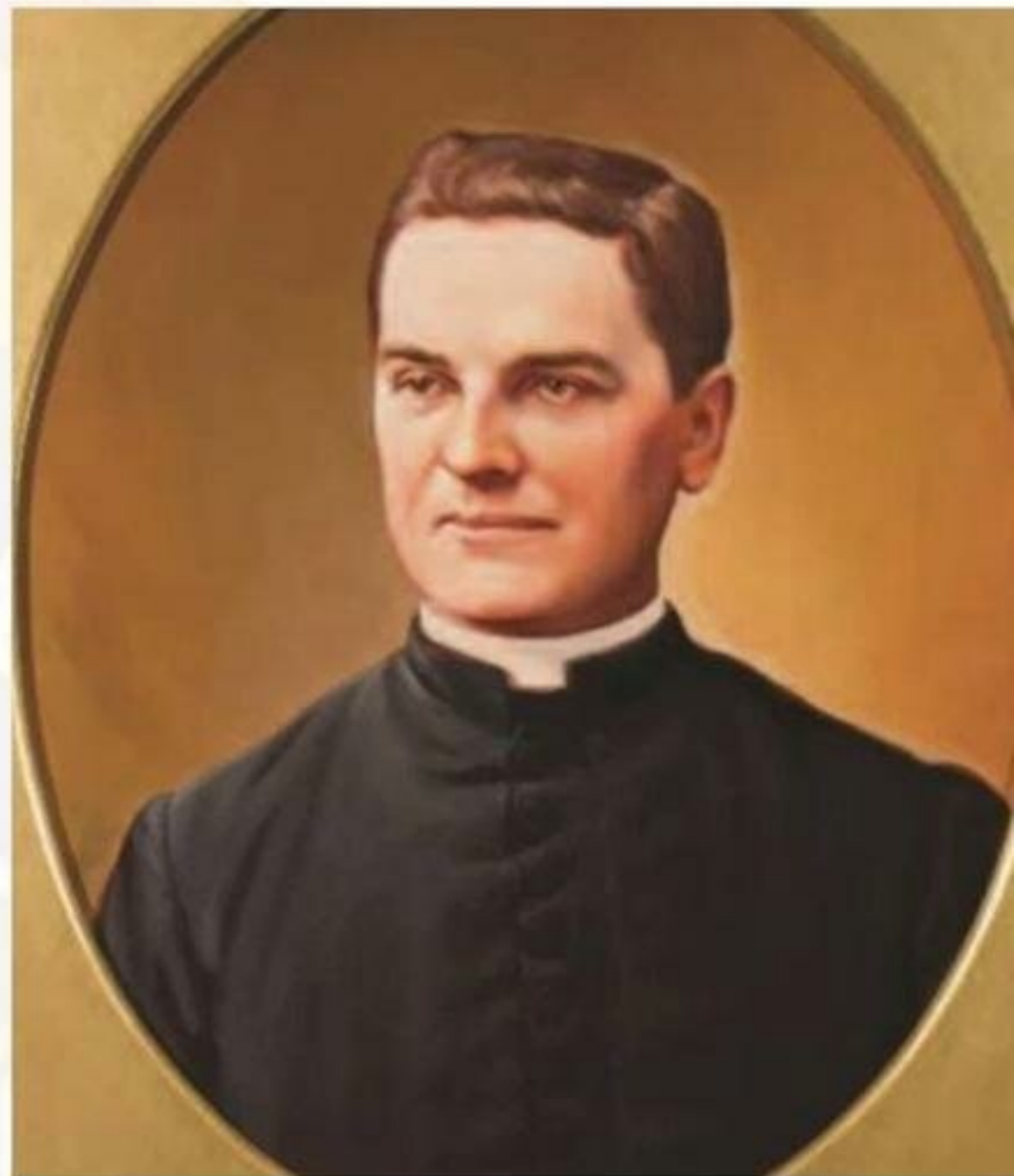
