

State Deputy Remarks

- Focus on (3-legged stool):
 - Faith
 - Encounter Christ daily in someone – be that for people
 - It's not what you do for God, it's what you allow God to do through you
 - Charity (programs)
 - Our Charity makes us better men & Catholics – gives meaning
 - This is what men are looking for – a life of meaning.
 - Membership
 - Who's responsibility?





State Deputy Remarks

- The goal is not the structure
 - The structure is the tool/vehicle to get you to the goal
- Faith
 - Goal to help formation of faith
 - One of the original goals of the Knights and Blessed Fr McGivney





State Deputy Remarks

- Faith
 - Don't ask your priest to come to a meeting to listen to arguing about money
 - Ask them to come to inspire
 - To pray
 - To do confessions
 - Etc.





State Deputy Remarks

- Faith - Membership
 - Without Fr McGivney the largest lay Catholic organization wouldn't exist
 - **Without you the members we wouldn't exist.**
 - Supreme Chaplain Archbishop Lori – we need dedication to Blessed McGivney.





State Deputy Remarks

- Membership - Faith
 - Most men that join the Knights are more established Catholics
 - We need to reach out to the young men that are searching for their faith and a way.
 - St Joseph – He said yes.
 - Model ourselves after St Joseph.





State Deputy Remarks

- Programs – Membership – Faith
 - Do your programs help retain and attract new members?
 - Men join for something meaningful, to do something important w/ their lives
 - Don't waste the time of a volunteer, they won't come back
- Why do you do a breakfast?
 - Give it a higher purpose and share that purpose with attendees & volunteers

- Programs - Faith
 - Faith In Action Programs
 - You can do programs without faith and “just check the box”, but why?
 - We can do them with faith, and have them be more meaningful, retain and attract new members, and be the way someone encounters Christ daily.

 - **Half or more** of new members should be from your programs and word of mouth
