CATHOLIC RECIPE: ST. MICHAEL'S GAUFRES

Also Called: St. Michael's Waffles

This is an American version of St. Michael's Gaufres, or waffles. In France, paper-thin sweet wafers called gaufres were baked by street vendors who set up their stands near the great cathedral to lure worshipers coming from Mass on St. Michael's Day to taste their wares. Not many people have a gaufrier, the special waffle iron used in France, but if you wish to serve waffles for supper on St. Michael's Day, you'll be right with tradition.

The Feast of St. Michael on September 29 has become a combined feast for the archangels Michael, Raphael and Gabriel. This feast is also called Michaelmas.


INGREDIENTS

- 2 eggs
- 1 egg yolk
- 2/3 cup sugar
- 1-1/3 cups flour
- 3/4-1 cup milk
- 4 Tablespoons melted butter
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla

DIRECTIONS

Blend eggs and sugar. Add flour and milk alternately. Beat hard. Add butter and vanilla. The mixture is thin and should spread evenly on the preheated iron. If Gaufres tend to stick, butter both sides of the iron. Serve hot or cold.

The four program categories are Faith, Family, Community, and Life and represent our main priorities as an Order. This model by no means seeks to eliminate the need for Knights to serve youth or foster fraternity; rather, it seeks to expand on these in a more holistic way.

- **FAITH:** Our goal is to strengthen our men and their families in the faith. When we entered the Order, we were reminded to constantly inform ourselves in the Catholic faith. This formation goes beyond mere facts or religious practice to an authentic connection with a loving God and his son Jesus Christ.
- **FAMILY:** Father Michael J. McGivney sought to strengthen the familial bond of father to mother and children to parents. Our family programs are an evolution and response to a society that seeks to weaken the bonds of family. We must make it clear that society should value a family that is faithful to God and each other.
- **COMMUNITY:** As Knights of Columbus, we are called to serve our family and our God. Our first principle is Charity, at home with our families or in our communities. This is a critical part of our Knights of Columbus mission.
- **LIFE:** The urgency of the threat to a culture of life cannot be misunderstood. Respect for the dignity of life demands a commitment to human rights across a broad spectrum. Both as Knights of Columbus and as followers of Christ, "Catholics must be committed to the defense of life in all its stages and in every condition" (Saint John Paul II, 1995). Sept. 28 – Nov. 6 - 40 Days for Life Fall Campaign - Barbara Granja, STM Respect Life Ministry Head will be heading up this Fall session. There will be a kick-off Prayer Rally on September 27th at 5:00 PM outside of the Planned Parenthood Metro clinic located at 160 S 1000 E, Salt lake City, UT 84102. It would be terrific if every Council could assemble a group to spend 1-hour in prayer outside the Planned Parenthood Metro Clinic at some point during the 40 Days. October is Pro-Life month. If you have not already done so, please try to work in at least one Life event during the month. This could be an hour spent at 40 Days for Life praying, setting up a novena for your Council and parish community, working with your pastor to do a pro-life homily and/or adoration hour, or supporting your local PRC or other event/activity. Don't forget about the new ASAP program Supreme has rolled out to aid and assist Pregnancy Resource Centers and other qualifying organizations. I encourage your Councils to read up on this new program and come up with new and creative ways to support the initiative. You can learn more by visiting www.KofC.org/ASAP

You may be wondering why there are still activities like 40 Days for Life taking place in Utah when Roe v Wade was overturned. Didn't Utah's Trigger law stop abortion in Utah? It did for about 48 hours until Planned Parenthood filed suit against the state. That case is now tied up in court. According to our friends at Pro Life Utah no one knows when or how this case will be settled. Obviously, Planned Parenthood has no desire to move things along. The Attorney General is trying to get the courts to allow the Trigger law to take effect while the case is being settled but that seems to be having issues as well.

The Utah Supreme Court may take the case but no word or guarantee on that. This could drag out for 1-4 years. So until this is settled, everything in Utah remains just as it was prior to the overturning of Roe. To say this is both frustrating and discouraging is a bit of an understatement. Brothers, this has been a big blow emotionally for our friends in the front-line organizations such as our PRCs, Pro Life Utah, and others. Anything you can do to help them or even just support them with a word of encouragement or an ask "what can we do for you?" would go a long way.

Again, please notify me as well as our State Program Director Bill McCauley of any upcoming events your Councils may have planned for the months ahead.


