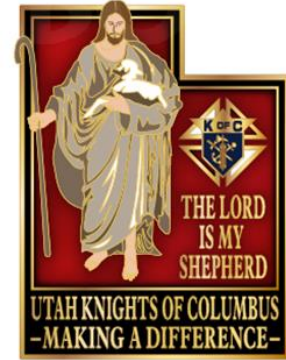

Brothers,

How many members in your Council have children, nieces, nephews, grandchildren, or neighbors who have Catholic children? Are those children ages 5 – 14? *Age eligibly is determined by the age of the contestant as of November 1.*

Those children ages 5 -14 are eligible to take part in the **Keep Christ in Christmas Poster Contest**. What child that age does not like to draw or paint pictures? Entries will be judged in three areas:

- Slogan – How clearly is the theme presented;
- Visuals – How well do the visuals convey the message? and
- Overall Impact – How effective was the poster in capturing your attention and causing you to reflect on the topic at hand?

This is a Faith in Action – Family Program. Entries are due to the Council by December 15. You can also seek entries from your parish CCD (religious education) classes and/or parochial school.

Maybe your Council could even advertise the contests in your parish bulletin or website. The **Keep Christ in Christmas Poster Contest** is open to the Catholic youth in your parish.
