

Abortion Trigger Law Timeline

- 2020 SB174 was passed and signed into law by Gov. Herbert
- 2022 Dobbs v. Women's Health Organization case to be heard by US Supreme Court.
- June 24, 2022 Court sided with Dobbs stating no "legal" right to abortion thus bringing an end to Roe V. Wade. Turns the legislation over to the states.
- June 24, 2022 Utah's trigger ban on elective abortion goes into place.
- June 27, 2022 Planned Parenthood & ACLU sue the state.
- Judge Stone sides with PP and a permanent injunction was granted to halt the law during the lawsuit.
- The injunction was appealed. The Utah Supreme Court agrees to look at the legality of the injunction. - This hearing should be in early 2023
- Lawsuit court date is set for September 2023 hearing 9 months away.
- To date over 1,500 babies lost to abortion since the injunction was granted.

Abortion Pills to Be Available More Widely Under New FDA Rules The FDA expanded access to a drug that induces abortion, allowing brick-and-mortar pharmacies to dispense the pills for the first time. Under changes to the rules outlined by makers of abortion pills, any pharmacy can complete and sign a short form to become certified to provide the so-called abortion pill, not just the handful of mail-order pharmacies that were permitted to ship prescriptions during the pandemic.







Affiliate Member Initiative January 1 to 31, 2023

During this window, councils may recommend qualified members to be designated as Affiliates. When processed, these members will no longer appear on council rosters. This will not be treated as a negative in eligibility for council awards. The Supreme Council will manage the future engagement of these members.





What are Affiliate Members (New Designation)

- Knights who are not involved with their local councils or assemblies
- Transferred into state roster/divisions
- Managed and engaged by Supreme





Affiliate Member Designation Process FINANCIAL SECRETARY PROCEDURES:

- 1. The Financial Secretary creates a list of eligible members to be recommended for designation as Affiliate Members.
 - i. Log on to Officers Online
 - ii. Click on the gold Member Management icon 3
 - iii. Click on the "Print Center MM" button on the top right of the page (Please refer to Figure II)
 - iv. Select the "Data Extract Tool" from the menu on the left side of the page
 - v. Select "Billing Info" from the drop-down menu
 - vi. Click the "Select All" buttons under the sections for "General Contacts", "Primary Address Information," and "Billing Information" (Please refer to Figure III)
 - vii. Click OK when the prompt appears
 - viii. Then press the "Get Extract" button in the bottom right-hand corner of the page. It may take several minutes before the data is delivered. Please be patient (Please refer to Figures IV and V)

procedure in step 1.b. below.





Affiliate Member Designation Process DISTRICT DEPUTY PROCEDURES:

1.Within ten (10) days of receiving the council's list, the District Deputy must complete the following actions:

- a. The District Deputy will review the list with the Grand Knight and satisfy himself that the criteria were equitably and fairly applied for all listed members, and that extenuating circumstances were considered.
- b. The District Deputy is not expected to personally verify the circumstances of each listed member.
- c. Upon approving the list, the District Deputy shall electronically submit it to the Membership Records Office at **affiliate@kofc.org** with copies to the GK, FS, and State Deputy and with the following attestation (Please refer to Figure XVII):
- d. If the District Deputy determines that the criteria were not satisfied or that extenuating circumstances were not adequately considered, he shall return the list to the Grand Knight for corrections along with a written explanation, with a copy to the State Deputy.
- e. If a council does not have a District Deputy, the State Deputy, or his appointed designee, will complete these actions.
