You Have Chosen To Be Leaders

- Know that YOU are critical to the growth of the Order AND to council success.
- Membership intake and engagement has been challenging for some councils post-COVID.
 - Zero recruiting councils
 - Re-engagement of members
- The Church needs our help!
- You can accept excuses or respond positively.
- As leaders, you must set the tone for council growth and member engagement.



Your Responsibility As Leaders

- Lead by Example
 - Be Positive
 - Inspire & Motivate
 - Teach and Train
 - Develop District and Council plans
 - Execute and Measure
 - Communicate often and Be Present
 - Don't commiserate.
 - Be Accountable and Enforce Accountability
- Be men of prayer





Leading on Membership Growth

- Embrace continuous improvement
- Be Present!
 - Attend council meetings
 - Convene District Meetings
 - Advise Grand Knights on how to improve
- Help councils find the right talent
- Encourage councils to put the best people in the right positions
- Share best practices regularly





Leading on Membership Growth

- Go back to basics:
 - Delta Church Drive training
 - A membership presence at every event
 - 1:1 recruiting "talk track"
- Create membership opportunities
 - Plan 1 District exemplification per month
 - Promote Supreme & State Incentives
 - Design your own District incentive
 - Promote online membership and Supreme virtual exemplifications
 - Get councils the training that they need
 - Seek Growth Directors Support





- Faith in Action Programs
 - Get all councils active and promoting Faith programs
 - Vivat Jesus Prayer Books
 - Eucharistic Procession Materials
 - Into the Breach Videos
 - Promote our programs to your councils, members, pastors and chaplains, and to the broader community
 - Treat the Columbian Award as a roadmap to success for councils
- New...COR. Educate about it and promote it.



National Eucharistic Revival!

"My Flesh for the Life of the World"

Mission: To renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

Vision: A movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission "for the life of the world."

3-year initiative

- K of C is a major partner
 - Developed resources that the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops shared with every diocese in the US.
- Launch date: June 19, 2022 (Corpus Christi Sunday)

- Strong programs lead to engaged members
- Engaged members = satisfied members
- Satisfied members not likely to defect
- Satisfied members will become advocates and will recruit new members





- If we give men what they want, we will never have a retention problem
 - Find out what men are looking to get out of their membership
 - Give them every chance to get it
 - Ensure councils are welcoming to new members
 - Encourage councils to get new members involved fast
 - Councils should conduct regular member surveys
- Help councils get credit for what they do and tell their story
 - Make STAR the goal for every council!
 - Strive to achieve STAR District
 - Take S.E. Training. Teach councils how to get complaint
 - File SP-7's and 1728 Forms before the deadline dates





- On time submission of new DD Council Evaluation Form DD 944 – due September 15 (hard due date!!!)
- Timely reporting of Fraternal Benefit Events
- 10784 Program reports each event...don't wait until June
- Open and Read Fraternal Leader Advisories
 - Require your council officers to do the same
- Make it a priority to attend Fraternal Webinars and encourage your councils to do the same
 - Promote these to your council officers and get them trained for success.



Start Fast

- Answer the "why" recruit and "why now" questions for councils – share the talk track
- Have a written District plan
- Ensure that all councils have plans ideally written plans - and work them – use the Financial Planner
- Instill a "culture of accountability" in all councils
 - Ensure that council leaders lead by example
- Ensure councils build strong relationships
 - With their pastors and that pastors know who we are and what we do!
 - With Field Agents
- Schedule Fraternal Benefit Events 2 per year
- Promote Supreme, State and District Incentives
