This carol, translated into English from an anonymous Latin hymn, speaks as a prayer about the first and second coming of Christ. It puts into words the deep longing that the saints of old had for the Messiah to come. The one that would redeem them from the bondages of their earthly lives.

I think back to Moses, Jeremiah, Isaiah, and many others who came to the end of their earthly lives still waiting for the promises of God to be fulfilled and still longing for the Messiah to come.

Yet for us, we know that Immanuel has come; the work of the cross is completed, the debt has been paid, forgiveness secured, and death has been defeated. Nonetheless, while we know that our future is secure, the end is still not here, and we still feel the pangs of sin and sickness in the in-between.

For saints, on this side of Immanuel's first coming, we too feel the longing and yearning for Messiah to come again.

At the Pregnancy Resource Center, we see the first-hand fallout of a sinful world. We see the damage of fractured families, the shattered dreams of broken promises, and the pain and grief caused by sinful behavior that commonly leads to sinful actions.

Yet the hope of Christmas, through the person of Jesus Christ, reminds us that we are not abandoned or alone. Every week, we get to share this truth with the women and families that come into the center.



JENNY'S* STORY:

Jenny arrived for her appointment at the PRC with bruises on her face and arms. Withdrawn, and barely able to speak, Jenny was met with a warm smile and reassurance that she was in a safe place.

While meeting with a Client Advocate, Jenny shared that her boyfriend regularly beat her, and she was afraid of what would happen if he found out she was here. In addition, Jenny was riddled with the guilt and shame of a past abortion. With no family support and an abusive boyfriend, Jenny spoke about her struggle with depression and how she had episodes of suicidal ideation. However, trying to drown her pain with drugs and alcohol was only making things worse.

It is often the case that many of the women that the center serves have never heard of their own worth, let alone the worth of their unborn children. It is not surprising, therefore, that many believe the lie that abortion is the answer.

Thankfully, that is not the end of the story.

Jenny shared how as a child, she used to go to church, but felt like she had "slipped away" from God. With Jenny's permission, a compassionate Client Advocate prayed with her and offered her a Bible that she gladly accepted. After having her options explained and learning about the vast number of resources available to her, Jenny's anxieties started to ease and her whole demeanor began to change

with a confirmed positive pregnancy test, Jenny smiled as she walked into the nurse's office for her ultrasound. Seeing her baby's tiny, pulsating heart, Jenny cried knowing she could not possibly abort another baby.

With Jenny's newfound resolve, the PRC staff arranged for medical care and emergency housing to get Jenny away from abuse and drugs. She joined the Life Steps parenting classes and was able to acquire every material item she and her baby needed. She has even found a local community of Christians that have accepted he and her child with unconditional love thanks to the PRC's church referral program.
