


Knights of Columbus[®] Utah State Council

Worthy District Deputies and Grand Knights,

To facilitate the Rose's passage through the State, the Rose should pass between the districts (Councils) starting in District One and exiting Utah through District Eight.

The Silver Rose arrives on June 9th and departs on July 6th. To make it as equitable as possible for all Councils within their districts to participate, I have established this tentative schedule. **District Deputies**, please check with your Mission churches and/or Parishes within your districts to ascertain if they too would like to venerate the Silver Rose. If scheduling permits, I may be able to add them to your district dates.

The following is the **tentative sequence**.

Before May 15th Let me know if the proposed schedule will work. At this point, we're trying to figure out who wants to host the Silver Rose. Submit your council number and the proposed date of your program to both myself and your district deputy. If your council doesn't want to host the Silver Rose this year, let me (and your DD) know that so the schedule can be opened up and days reallocated to those who are interested.

Before May 29th, please provide the necessary information about your program to me so I can submit the required information to Supreme. **The "Silver Rose Jurisdiction Schedule form" #10720** has to be submitted to Supreme in advance of the Silver Rose arrival. **If your council does not provide the following information, the Grand Knights will be assigned as the Point of Contact.**

Silver Rose Reporting: Councils report their Silver Rose hours in the Faith in Action "Fraternal Programs Report Form" **#10784** online – <u>Click here</u> to submit your membership number and last name to receive the form 10784 link in your email. (<u>Video on using Form 10784</u>)

Transferring the Rose: District Deputies/Councils need to coordinate the transfer of the Rose between the individual councils/districts themselves. District Deputies can submit and be reimbursed for mileage traveled in transferring the Rose; **Reminder: miles submitted cannot exceed the district boundaries**. Record the total distance traveled to either pick-up or transfer the Rose to another council. **Reminder**, on form #10784, "Distance Traveled" make sure you enter the miles, not kilometers, when filling out the form.

Note: When submitting form #10784 to Supreme, please send me a copy. It will assist me in completing my report for the State.

When submitting your council's plans, make sure you provide the link to any virtual or hybrid services, along with the usual information of date, time, location, and contact information. The same information that is needed (by May 29th) for the form 10720 mentioned above.
