And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Messiah." (Gospel for Sept. 15, Mk 8:29)

Peter was the first of the apostles to openly profess Jesus as the awaited Messiah, the Christ or anointed one. Today, every Christian is called to proclaim in word and deed that Jesus is the Christ. We must never lose the awe and wonder of recognizing Jesus as the Messiah and Savior, especially when we encounter him in the sacrament of penance and in the Mass.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to make Peter's profession of faith — "You are the Messiah" — a frequent aspiration, or short prayer, you recite throughout each day, perhaps writing it down some place you will see it regularly to remind yourself.

Questions for Reflection:

When you say the name of Jesus Christ, are you mindful of what this truly means? When you approach a priest for confession, are you fully cognizant that the absolution you receive through the priest comes from Christ himself? When you approach holy Communion, do you recognize and contemplate Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist you receive?



VSM Message September 2024

Worthy Sir Knights, last month in Quebec our Supreme Knight introduced the theme of this year when he called us to remain "on mission." He recalled not only the mission given to us by our founder, Father McGivney but also the commission given to the Apostles by Our Lord Jesus Christ. This reminds us of our baptismal commission to be disciples – to grow in relationship to Jesus and invite others to join us in the ways we're growing.

Into this environment of renewed excitement of discipleship and the mission, we welcome our new district masters as they begin their terms of office. They are well prepared for their roles thanks to the Supreme Master and his training team who created and presented a "New Master Training" program that covered all their responsibilities and shared best practices from across the Order. I am confident they will step off smartly with a "we will succeed" attitude to build a district and province culture of positivity. The overarching tone for the Fourth Degree leadership this year is success through forward-looking planning to achieve assigned goals. Every leader in the province needs a plan containing assigned and personal goals for growth, recruitment, activities, member engagement and enrichment. I have a plan, the Masters have a plan, to reach their assigned and personal goals and help assemblies grow in service to Church and community and be the patriotic Catholic citizens we all pledged to be.

Every Faithful Navigator needs a plan to lead his assembly to grow in service to Church, Country and community. These plans need to be in written form and available for monthly review. No leader should just "think" he'll achieve his goals. He should have a document that defines how to achieve them and measure his progress towards them. At a minimum, to grow the membership, to support the Bishops and Priests, and demonstrate and teach the principle of patriotism should be the mission of every assembly.

We are *on mission*, in the words of our Supreme Knight; we must have "the zeal of Father McGivney to build the next generation of Catholic men by growing the organization and forming Catholic men in faith and virtue, so they're prepared to serve as missionary disciples."

Being on mission is a focused activity - to go out, to seek, to find something or someone, to share something, to achieve an objective. The phrase "having a mission" conjures up all sorts of images and thoughts of military operations and nowadays of sports teams using "weapons" to score points and win games. But there is another side for us being *on mission*; which is to welcome, invite, embrace who we find. Our mission is to seek out those Catholic men and families who are not yet Knights or Sir Knights and invite them to join us. Our "weapons" to achieve the objective of welcoming a new member are the rosary, prayer, the story of Father McGivney, the work of the Order and the manner in which we live our lives as men who are religiously devoted and patriotically proud.

This is not an easy mission, but it is a necessary one because a not-so-subtle anti-Catholic discrimination is re-emerging and we are engaged in what our Supreme Knight describes as "... not just fighting legal and policy battles. We are fighting what John Paul II described as a 'culture of death' and what Pope Francis has called a 'throwaway culture.'"

The very foundations of our spiritual lives are under attack, none of us can be a spectator. At our baptism we were commissioned to be missionary disciples. It is time to act, to advance the truths of our faith and the goals of our Order. For guidance we have the Church and our Order. For inspiration we look to our savior, Jesus Christ, and our founder, Blessed Michael McGivney, who challenged the evils and wrongdoings, overcame the obstacles and lived their lives in service to others. Indeed, "The days of easy faith are over," as Supreme Knight Kelly says. It is time for each of us as St. Paul tells us, to stand firm, with integrity as a breastplate, carrying the shield of faith, wearing salvation as a helmet, and carrying the Word of God as a sword. As Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI reminded us: "It is imperative that the entire Catholic community in the United States comes to realize the grave threats to the Church's public moral witness."

Our Church is in need of men willing to be the strong right arm of the Church. When we stand united, our Order is a force for the defense of our faith, our families, and one another.

Our mission - grow our membership and defend our faith, families and one another. Are you willing to accomplish this mission?



Colorado Master William Furstenberger

William Fuerstenberger graduated from Greeley Central High School in 1967. He attended Southern Colorado State College in Pueblo where he earned his BS in Political Science, with a minor in Geography. From there, he continued his Teachers Education at the University of Northern Colorado where he received his Master's Degree in Curriculum and Instruction in 1974. William met his beautiful wife of 52 years, Pat, while studying at UNC. William taught high school in Elizabeth, Colorado for 5 years, then took an internship with the National Highway and Traffic Safety Administration in Atlanta, Georgia. Eventually they moved to Michigan to pursue his Doctorate Degree, graduating with an Education Specialist Degree in 1982. William and Pat moved to Cripple Creek, Colorado in 1984 where they raised their family for 14 years. In 1998 they moved to Windsor, CO and started attending Our Lady of the Valley Catholic Church.

William's journey with the Knights of Columbus began in 2007 when he became a member, rising to the rank of Sir Knight in 2008. In subsequent years he assumed various leadership roles, including serving as Faithful Navigator from 2010-2012 and as District Marshal from 2012-2016. He held the position of Grand Knight of Council 11575 from 2015-2016, followed by his current role as Adjunct District Marshal since 2016. Additionally, he served as District Deputy in District 1 from 2017-2021.

"I feel strongly that the opportunity to be District Master is my vocation and that the Lord is calling me with courage, faith, hope and trust. I plan to expand the 4th degree by focusing on supporting existing members with education, leadership programs and a shared sense of purpose within the assembly. I will continue to promote attendance at the C.O.R meetings, aiming to nurture and fortify Catholic men in their faith and virtue. Additionally, I will focus on recruitment initiatives emphasizing the exclusive advantages and experiences accessible to 4th degree members, including engagement in Honor Guards, patriotic activities/events and the acquisition of leadership proficiencies essential for effective organizational management. I plan to introduce a unique program designed to encourage engagement with veterans in need and individuals experiencing homelessness. I will personally promote adherence to the guidelines outlined in the 4th Degree Color Corps Manual, and I will personally commit to continuing my involvement in the Honor Guard. As the new Master of the Colorado District in the John H. Reddin Province, I look forward to visiting assemblies across the state promoting joint initiatives that align with the mission of the 4th degree and promote the bond of brotherhood, patriotism, civic engagement, service to others and also engage in the mission of the Catholic Church".

As we continue the Fraternal Year 2024-2025, I am pleased to introduce myself as the new Colorado District Master, effective September 1st. I would like to express my appreciation and gratitude for the hard work and dedication of District Master Dave Davis, who has just completed four years. 


