





- ➤ CUF as soon as possible, utilize online tool, follow up with in person CUF at church, meeting w/ social activity
- ➤ Transfer to council after CUF using prospect tool CUF date
- ➤ Update degree status Member Mgmt/Fraternal Info why?
- ➤ Member transfers, reinstatements, affiliate to active use candidate tab and input information.

- Update need to highlight programs and refer leaders to the current month newsletter







What does every Catholic man need? Cor Initiative




- Active and growing relationship with God

How are we going to bring men to Jesus Christ?


Cor Initiative


What is Cor?

- Intentional and frequent time for:
 - Prayer
 - Formation
 - Fraternity
- Open to all men of the parish
- In service of the Pastor & requires his permission
- Not meant to compete with other men's ministries but to strengthen and support

<u>Cor</u> - Formation <u>Centered Example</u> (60 - 90 min.)

- 1. Fraternity: Coffee and donuts with short welcome
- 2. <u>Formation</u>: Into the Breach Video and small group discussion
- 3. <u>Prayer</u>: Rosary








Building Support from the State Level Cor Initiative


Knights and FORMED Cor Initiative


